IAPT Seminar



Dr Jagdish Chandra Basu, the first modern scientist of India, born on November 30, was an Indian polymath, physicist, biologist, biophysicist, botanist and archaeologist, and an early writer of science fiction. He pioneered the investigation of radio and microwave optics, made significant contributions to plant science, and laid the foundations of experimental science in the Indian subcontinent. IEEE named him one of the fathers of radio science. Dr Basu is considered as the father of Bengali science fiction, and also invented the crescograph, a device for measuring the growth of plants. A crater on the moon has been named in his honour. To memorize and honour the works of the great scientist, the institute organized a seminar in association with Indian Association of Physics Teacher (IAPT) RC-9 & Vijnana Bharati on November 30, 2019 which is the birthday of Dr. Basu. The seminar was graced with the presence of Dr. P.K. Dubey, Retired professor from P.M.B. Gujrati Science College & member of IAPT; Dr. P.K. Sharma, Professor in Holkar Science College & member of IAPT; Dr. Usha Singh, Professor in IPS Academy & member of IAPT and Dr. Uttam Sharma, Professor SVVV & Secretary of IAPT. field of physics & to enhance their interest in this subject and enlighten their hidden potentialities. The event was coordinated by Dr. Namrata Soni.



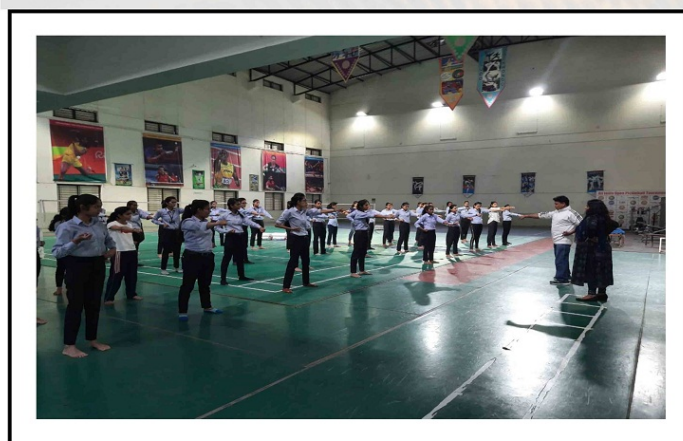

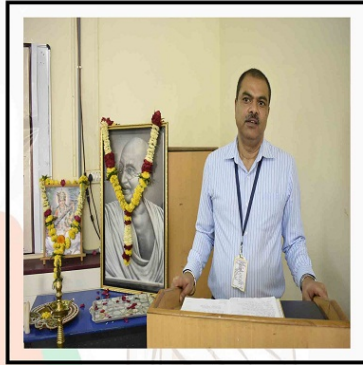


Gandhi Jayanti : A Tribute to The Father of Nation
