### IMPROVING QUALITY IN HIGHER EDUCATION AND RESEARCH IN DIGITAL ERA: CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES



On February 6-7, 2020 Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the Institute organized two days National Conference on 'Improving Quality in Higher Education and Research in Digital Era: Challenges and Opportunities'. The main objective of this conference was to explore the new ways to bring qualitative improvement in higher education and promote research. The inaugural program of the conference was graced with the presence of luminary of management education Professor Dr. Himanshu Rai, Director Indian Institute of Management Indore as chief guest. 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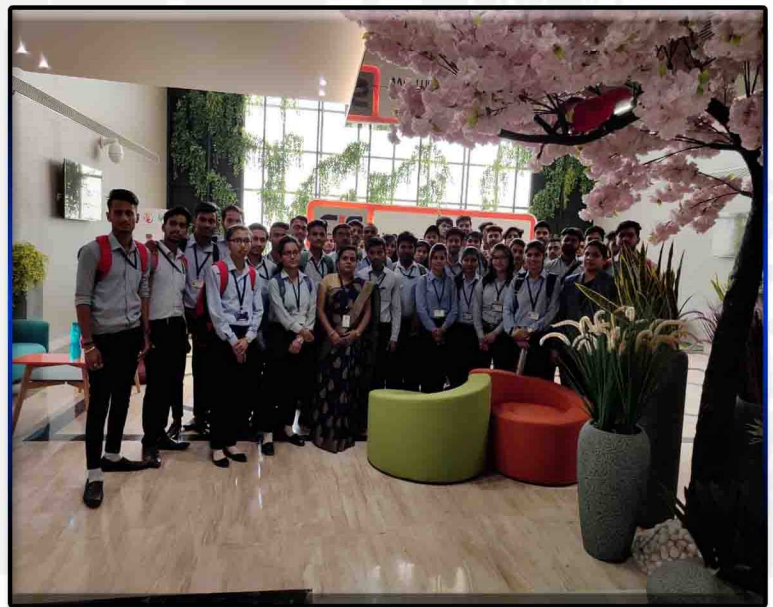
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
