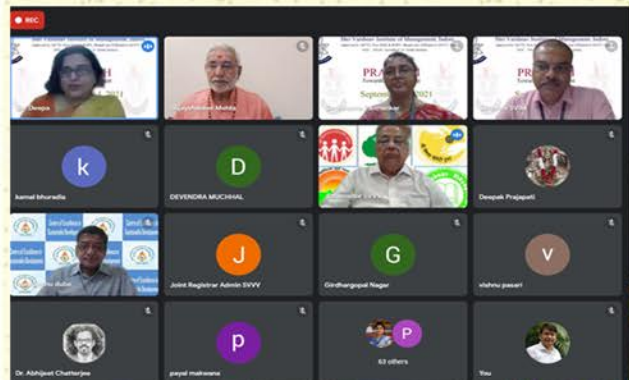
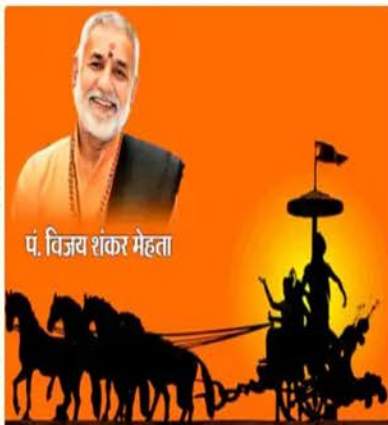


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Towards enlightenment.....

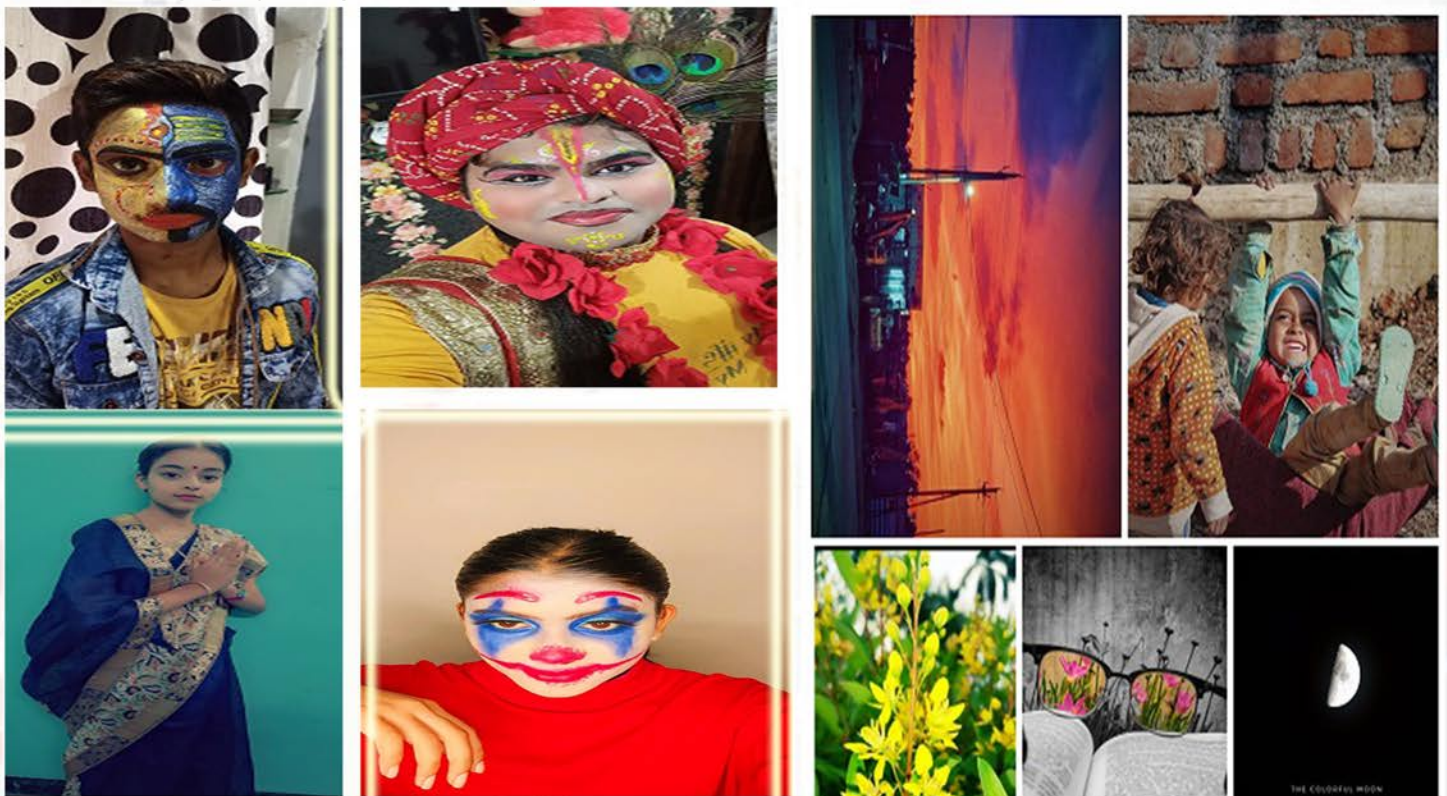

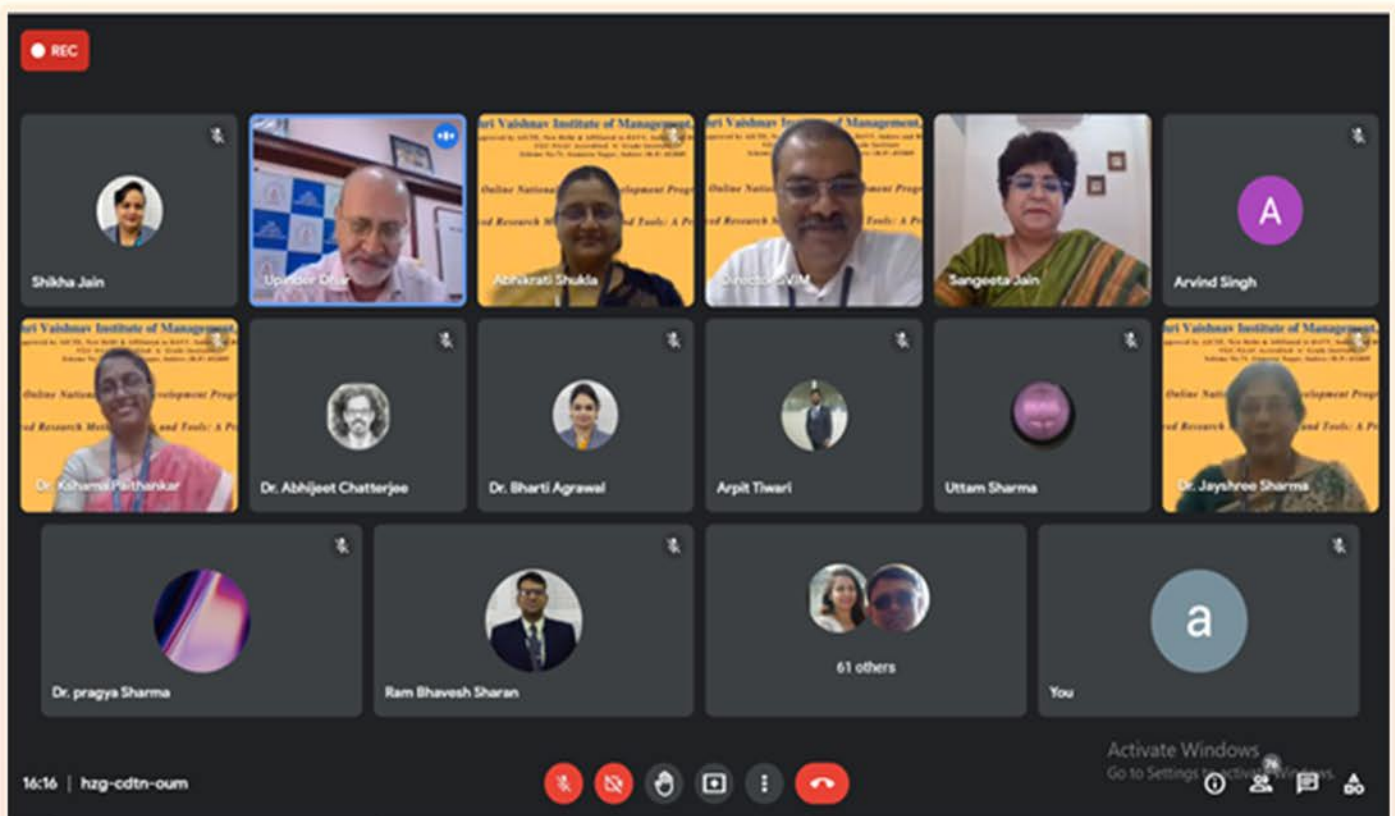

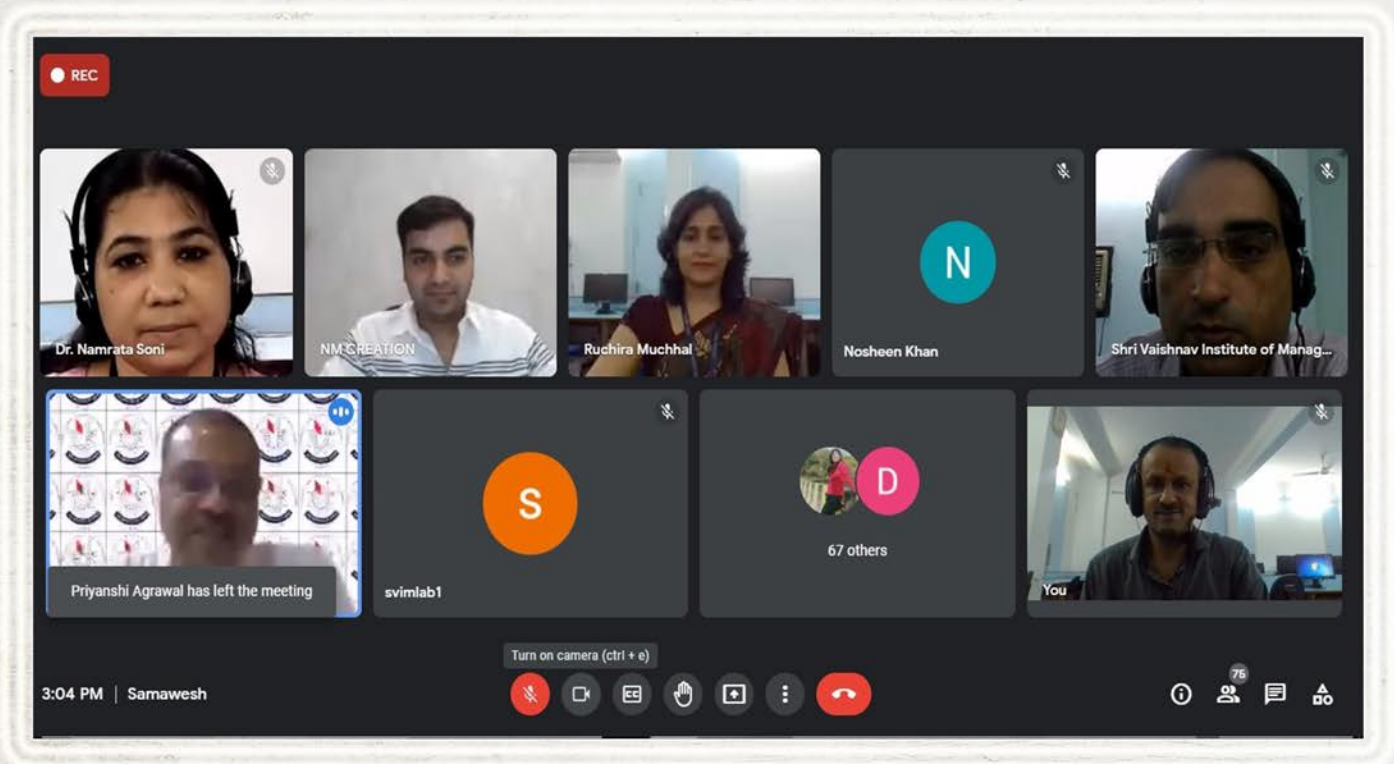
Free Vaccination Camp

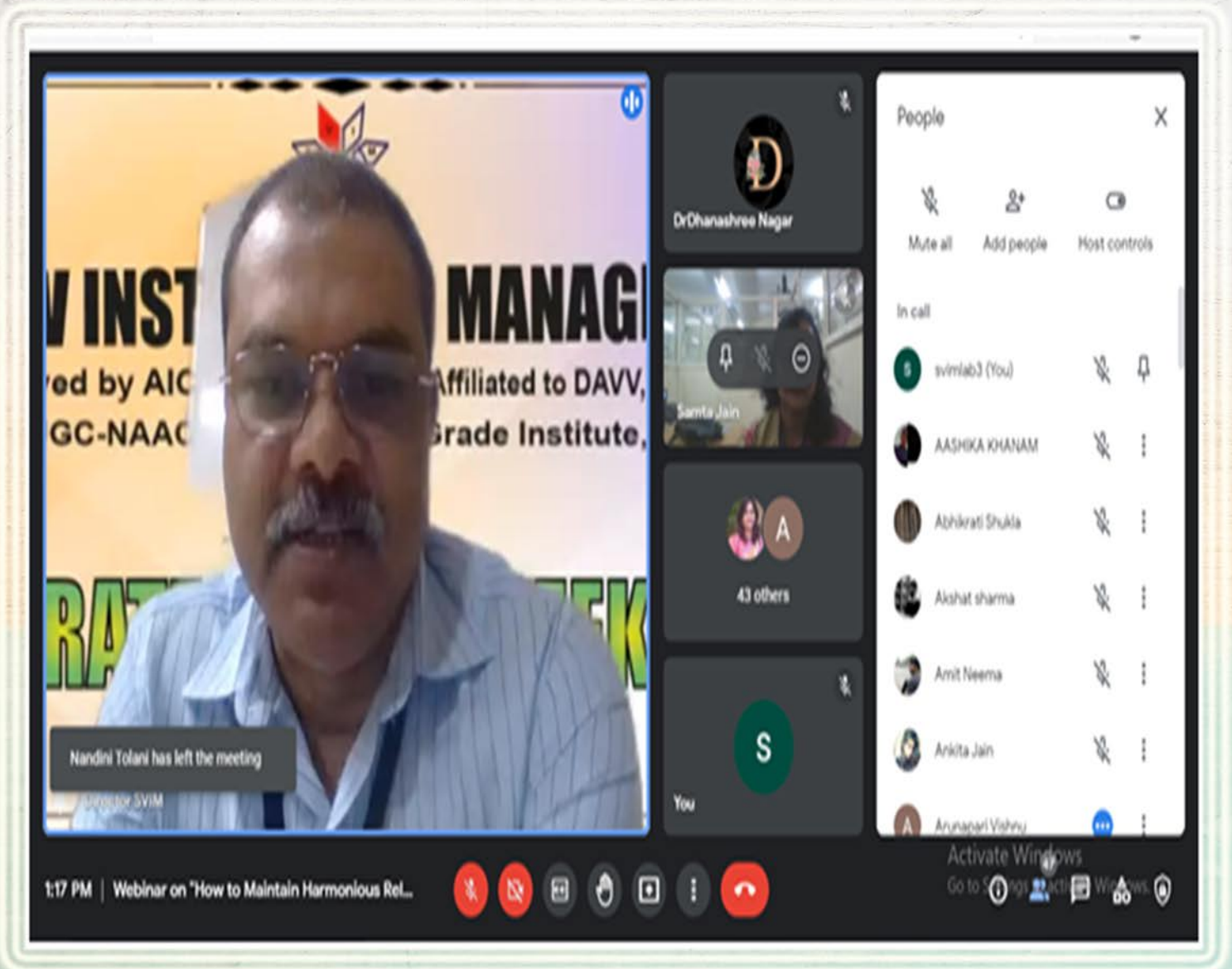
DAKSH

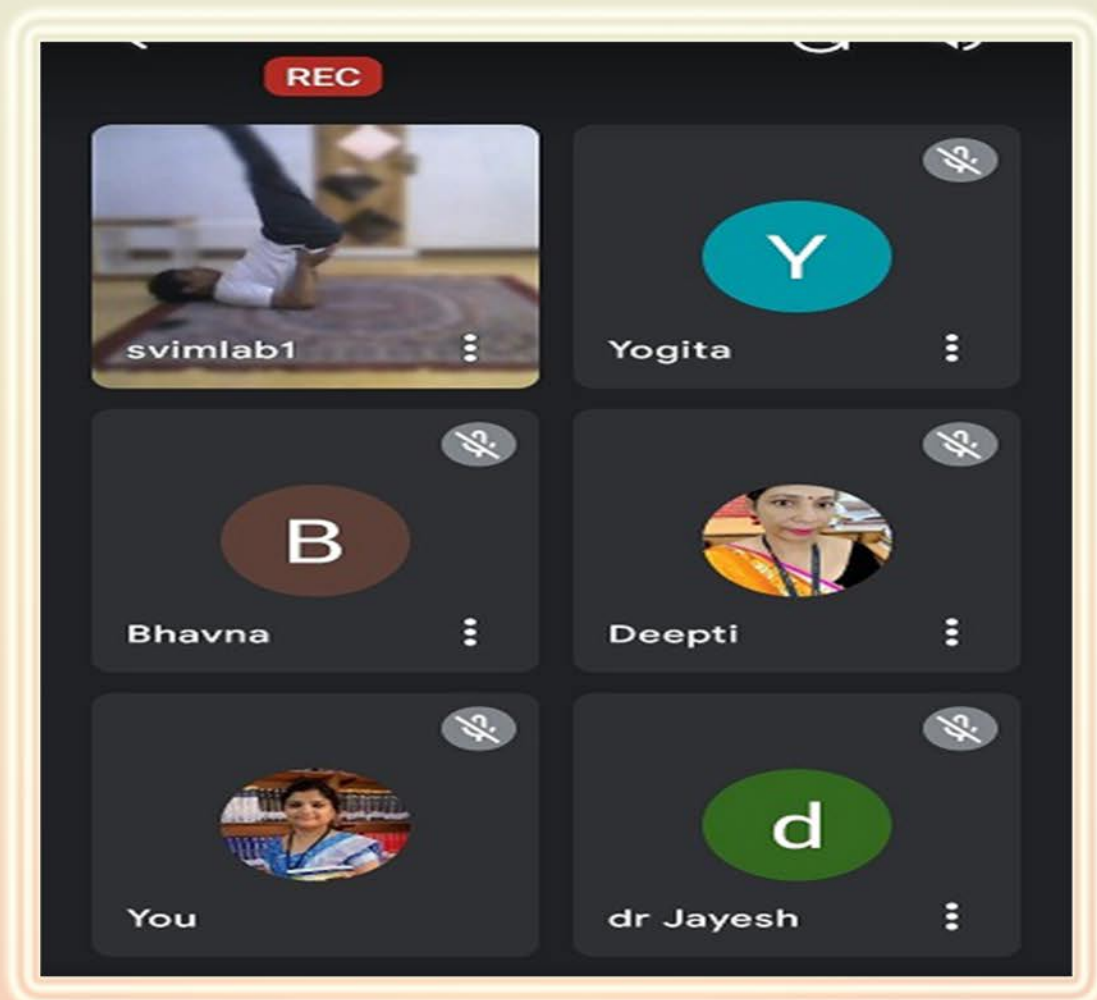

for Peaceful Mind & Soul

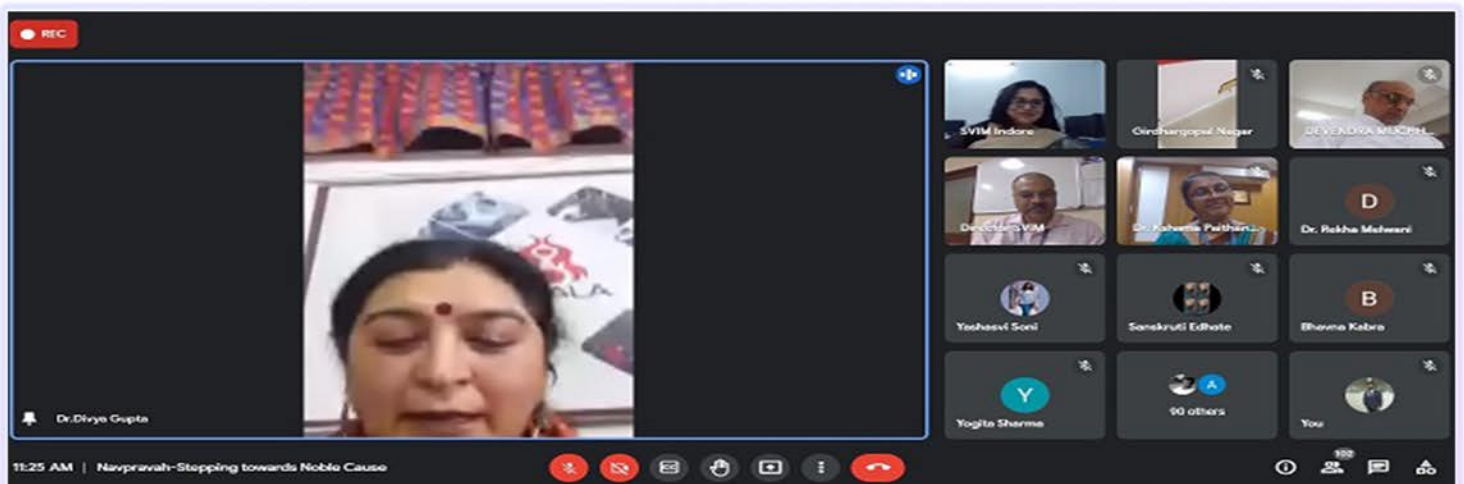

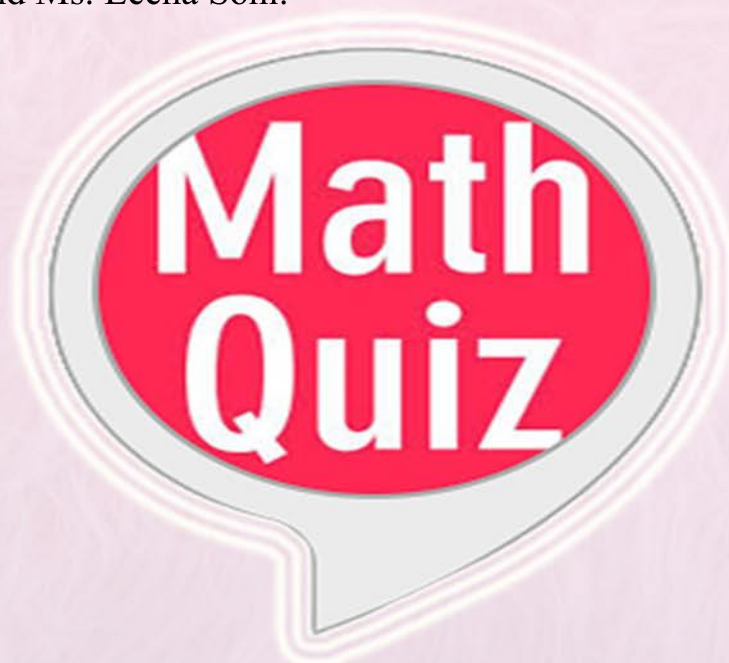
Maths Gym

Ganesh Utsav

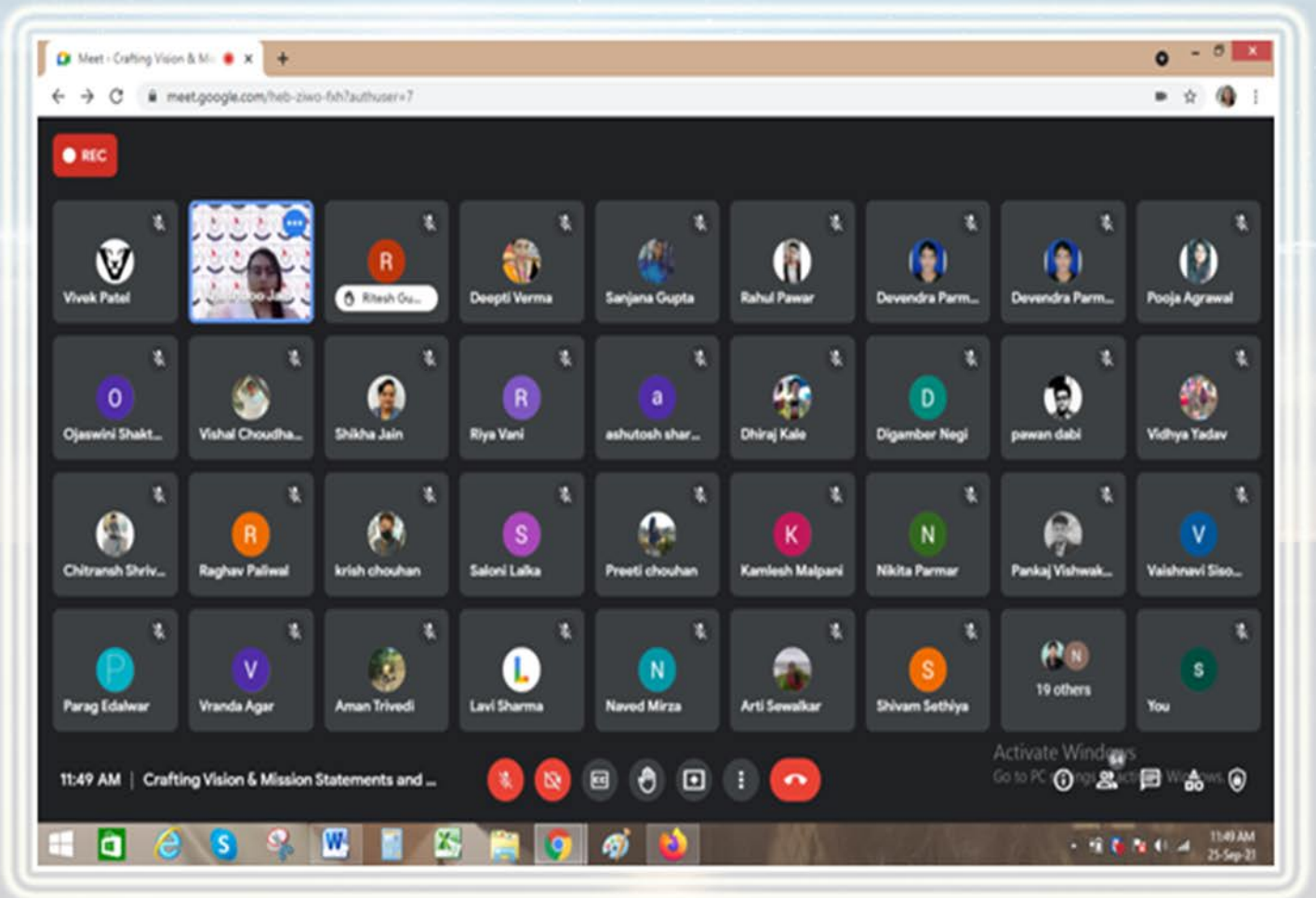
