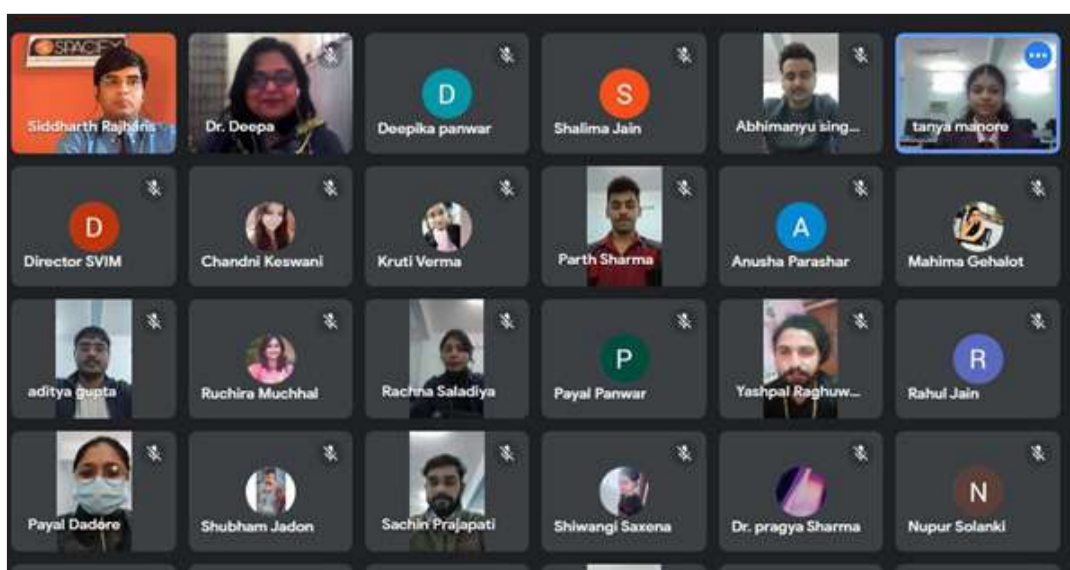

Case Analysis Workshop

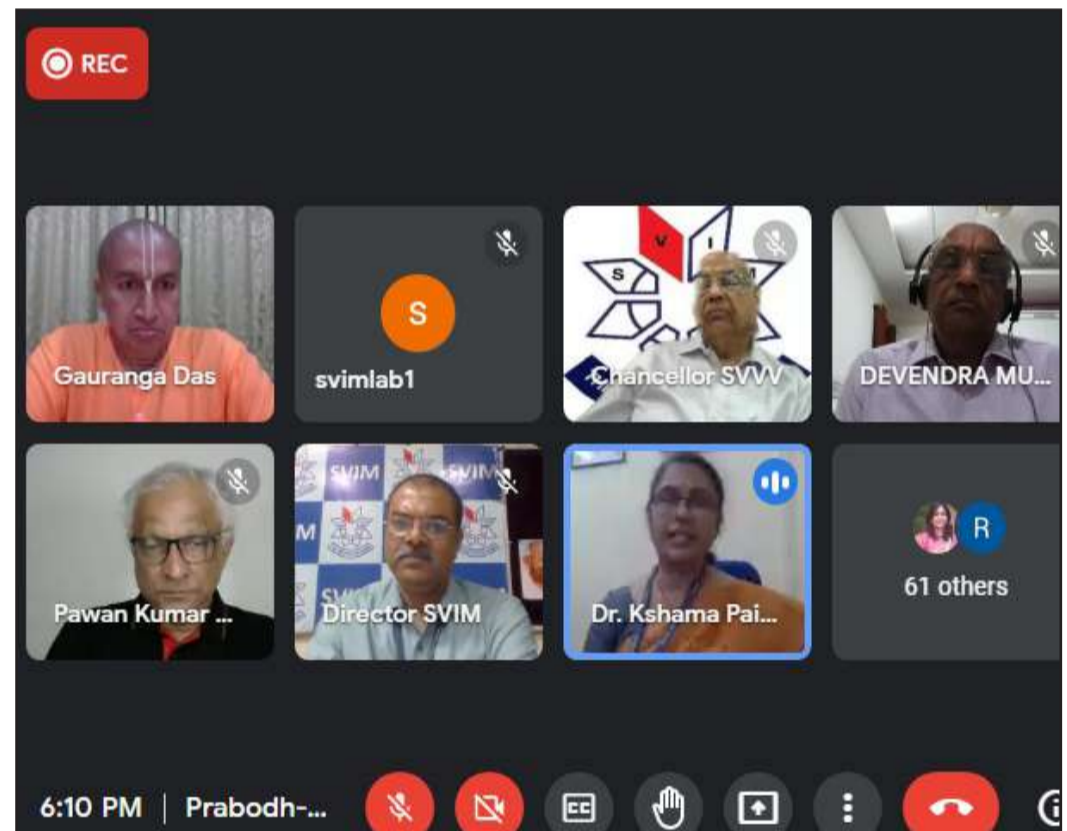

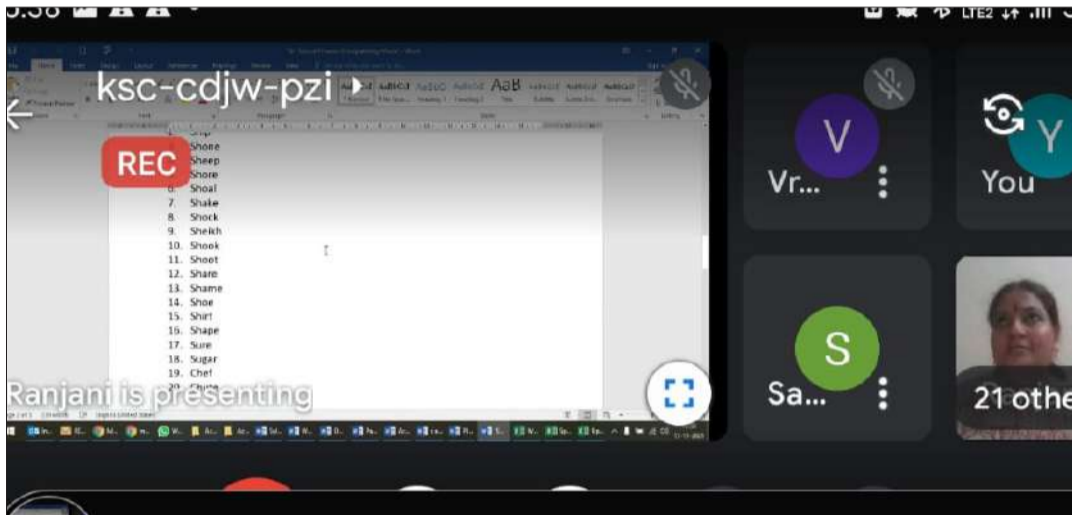

Regular blood testing is an important way to keep track of overall well-being. Getting testing regularly can help to visualize the changes body undergoes and empowers to make informed decisions about health. Blood tests provide a crucial picture of overall health and well-being. These investigations aid in the early identification of an illness, which in turn, can avoid its progression into more severe stages.



With this objective institute organized a blood test camp on December 9, 2021 under Employee Welfare Program. National Case Writing Workshop 2021-22

The case method is a participatory, discussion-based way of learning where students gain skills in critical thinking, communication, and group dynamics. It is a type of problem-based learning. To encourage the use of Case method, the Case Development Cell of the Institute organized 9th National Case Writing Workshop from November 22-27, 2020 in online mode. Dr. Upinder Dhar; Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Shri Vaishnav Vidyapeeth Vishwavidyalaya has been the resource person for the workshop. After the brief inaugural program the pre-lunch session on the first day was based on the importance of Case study and the process of developing a Case on real life situations. The participants were divided into five groups each of comprising 4-5 participants. Each group contacted the allotted organization such as GFID India, Dee Tee Industries, Goyal Industries, and PR 24X7 and collected the information by discussing the organizational persons virtually in the second half of the day. On the second day, each group conversed with the resource person about the information collected and had the direction to draft the case. The post lunch session was focusing on drafting the case. On the third day, each group had the opportunity to read the Case in front of resource person and edit accordingly, and then re-draft the case until the final case study outlined. On the fourth day, the speaker gave the guidelines for preparing the teaching notes which need to be included with the Case. On the fifth day, groups presented the Cases prepared by them one by one. On day sixth, facilitator explained how Case is to be taught through taking a sample case. The workshop ended with the closing ceremony where the participants shared their feedback and appreciated the efforts of the organizers. HIV/AIDS Awareness

Each year, on December 1, the world commemorates World AIDS Day. People around the world unite to show support for people living with HIV and to remember those who have died from related illnesses. Every year, United Nations agencies, governments and civil society join together to campaign around specific themes related to HIV. This year's theme was **End inequalities, End AIDS, End pandemic.**

To create awareness among students regarding this deadly disease, institute organized a seminar on December 3, 2021 in collaboration with Red Ribbon Club. Ms. Shalini Jain, Psychologist and counselor, for HIV/AIDS awareness, Government Hospital, Indore; was keynote speaker of the event

Dr. Jain shared that HIV is a virus that damages the immune system. Over the time, as HIV kills more CD4 cells, the body is more likely to get various types of conditions and cancers. She also added that HIV is transmitted through bodily fluids that include: blood, semen, vaginal and rectal fluids, breast milk etc.

She further explained that with medical care, including treatment called antiretroviral therapy, it's possible to manage HIV and live with the virus for many years. Without treatment, a person with HIV is likely to develop a serious condition called the Acquired Immuno Deficiency Syndrome, known as AIDS. At that point, the immune system is too weak to successfully respond against other diseases, infections, and conditions. Session followed by the query session where Dr. Jain answered the queries of the students. Program was well conducted by Ms. Ruchira Muchhal. The session came to an end by vote of thanks, proposed by Dr. Jitendra Jain.



Urjita- Self Defense Program

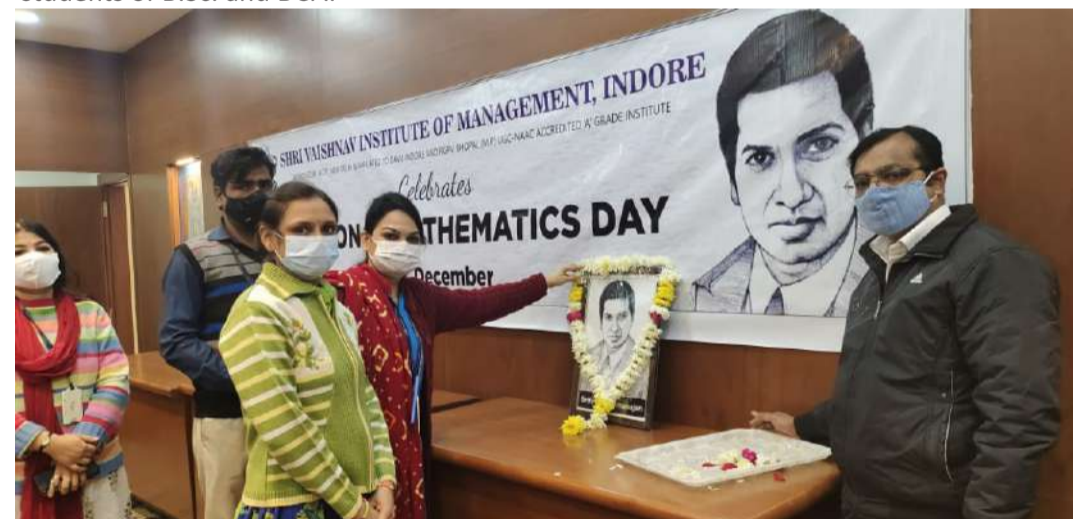

Mathematical Quiz

"Life is a math equation. In order to gain the most, you have to know how to convert negatives into positives."

December 22 is marked as the National Mathematics Day every year, remembering one of India's greatest mathematicians Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujan, who contributed to explaining the analytical theory of numbers and worked on elliptic functions, continued fractions, and infinite series. Former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh in 2012 declared December 22 as National Mathematics Day to honour the legendary mathematician. To celebrate this great day and to improve mathematical knowledge skills of the students a Quiz was organized by Department of Computer Science on December 22, 2021 for students of B.Sc. and BCA.



At the onset Dr. Jayesh Tiwari enlighten student with the life and works of great mathematicians Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujan Ramanujan's that his knowledge of mathematics was startling. His mastery of continued fractions was unequalled by any living mathematician. He worked out the Riemann series, the elliptic integrals, hypergeometric series, the functional equations of the zeta function, and his own theory of divergent series, in which he found a value for the sum of such series using a technique he invented that came to be called Ramanujan.

The session continued with the Quiz for the students. The Quiz consisted of 40 mathematics related questions covering calculus, differentiation and integration, number theory, matrix and vector calculus. Students who answered correctly were given gifts. This Quiz helped students to identify their knowledge level and motivated them to practice more. The Quiz executed by Dr. Jayesh Tiwari, Dr. Jagdish Sharma, Ms. Yogita Sharma, Dr. Arti Sevalkar and Ms. Leena Soni extremely well.

Women Safety & Prevention

Women play a vital role in human progress and have a significant place in the society. 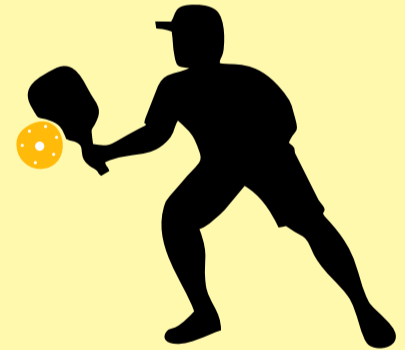
