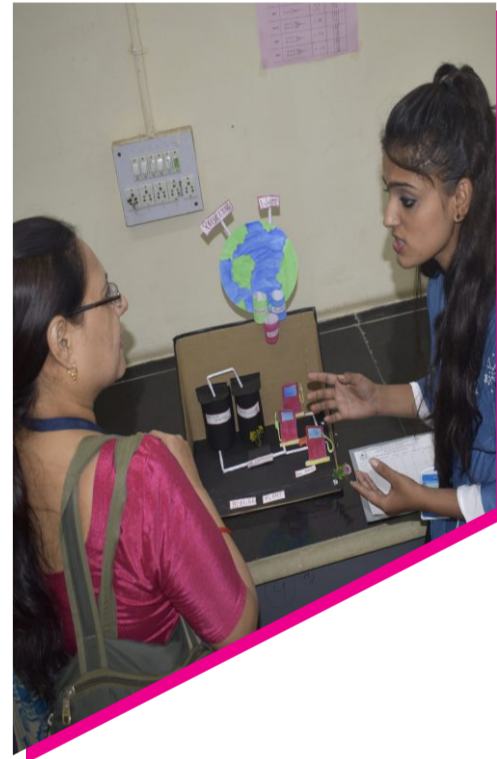


## Management Fest

Chief Guest, Dr. Pankaj Mittal explained the education scenario before pandemic and after pandemic; before NEP and after NEP. The Guest of Honour, Dr. Pradeep Kumar said that before Covid, traditional methods of teaching and learning were popular. Post Covid, 90% of teaching has shifted to online learning.
