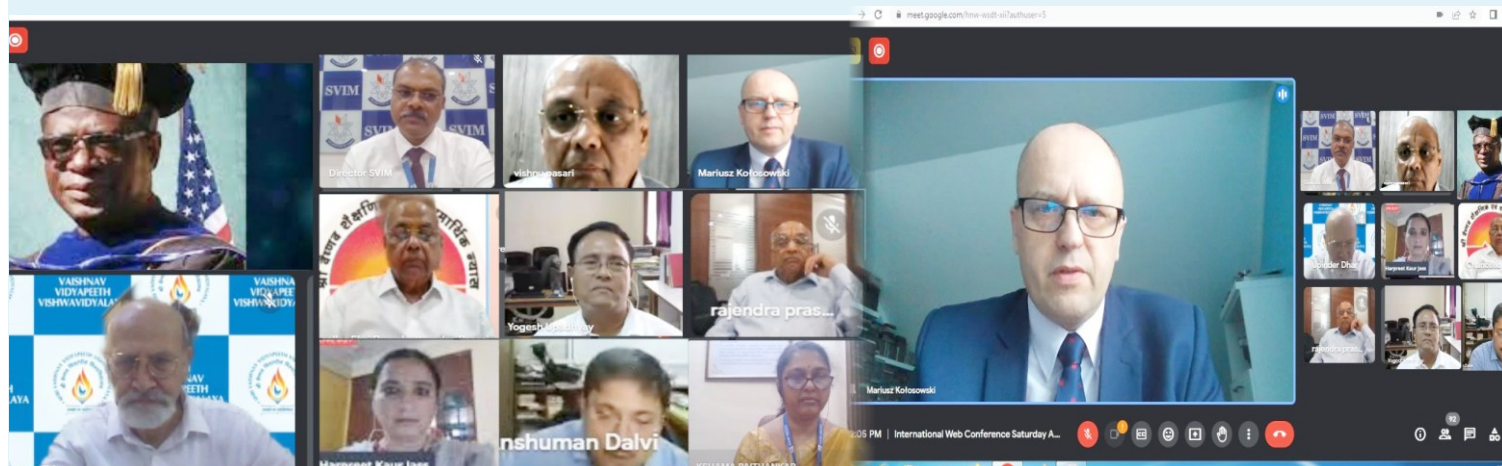




# INTERNATIONAL WEB CONFERENCE
