The Experts' views and the competition brought out awareness among the students about Women's Safety, Gender Discrimination and Gender Equality.

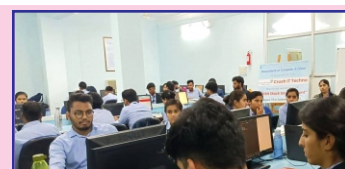

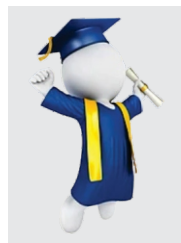

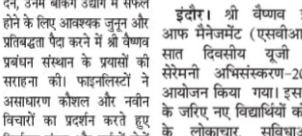
