Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) is the space agency of India. The organization is involved in science, engineering and technology to harvest the benefits of outer space for India and the mankind.

The prime objective of ISRO is the development and application of space technology for various national needs. To fulfil this objective, ISRO has established major space systems for communication, television broadcasting and meteorological services; resources monitoring and management; space-based navigation services. ISRO has developed satellite launch vehicles, PSLV and GSLV, to place the satellites in the required orbits.

In order to fulfill the commitment of experiential learning, 50 students of BCA and B.Sc programmes of Computer Science Department visited Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), Ahemdabad under the guidance of Dr. Jayesh Tiwari, Dr. Jitendra Jain, Dr. Namrata Soni and Mrs. Yogita Sharma. The main objective of the visit was to provide information to the students in the fields of astronomy, stellar physics, atmospheric science, space research, Chandrayaan-3 launch and technology, to inspire students

to build their future in the field of space science so that they can bring glory to the Institution and to the country.

The team was welcomed at Vikram Sarabhai Space Exhibition by Chief Scientist Mr. N. J. Bhatt and team and with senior scientist Dr. Anil Sukheja. Mr. Bhatt briefed about the various activities and successful missions at the Sarabhai Space Center including Chandrayaan I, II, III, Aditya L1, the historic Mars mission. He explained that the objective of Chandrayaan-3

mission was soft landing, and after that all the necessary data was collected in the experiments conducted for the next 14 days. This was ISRO's seventh mission. Students got a chance to see the cutting-edge technology and equipment used in various space missions. This practical experience provided students with a practical understanding of the complexities involved in space research.

It has been an incredible experience for the students to see the actual functioning of ISRO. The visit ignited student curiosity and inspired them to dream and achieve their goals.



Antimicrobial Resistance



Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) occurs when bacteria, viruses, fungi and parasites no longer respond to antimicrobial agents. As a result of drug resistance, antibiotics and other antimicrobial agents become ineffective and infections become difficult or impossible to treat, increasing the risk of disease spread, severe illness and death.

The World AMR Awareness Week (WAAW) is a global campaign to raise awareness and understanding of AMR and promote best practices among

stakeholders to reduce the emergence and spread of drugresistant infections. WAAW is celebrated from 18-24 November every year.

The theme for WAAW 2023 was "Preventing antimicrobial resistance together". To make students aware of the antimicrobial resistance that pathogenic microbes are developing due to overuse or misuse of antibiotics, a Poster Competition was organized on November 24, 2023 for the students of B.Sc (Biosciences I, Year (Biotechnology, Microbiology and Bioinformatics) on the theme "Antimicrobial Resistance". The students presented very informative and creative posters on the specified theme.

effective product (free of contamination).

Mr. Nitesh Jasani, Director and Founder, Jaiv Vatika was the resource person. Mr. Jasani explained the entire process of biofertilizer and biopesticide production. He made students aware about the disadvantages of chemical fertilizers and pesticides and the beneficial aspects of biofertilizer and biopesticides for sustainable agriculture.

Hands on training on MERN Stack Development



MERN is one of several variations of the MEAN stack (MongoDB Express Angular Node), where the traditional Angular.js frontend framework is replaced with React.js. The MERN architecture allows to easily construct a 3-tier architecture (frontend, backend, database) entirely using JavaScript and JSON.

With an objective to train the students in a new technology keeping in view the need of the corporate world, Department of Computer Science organized a one week workshop on "How to be MERN Stack Developer" for the students of MCA III semester from August 21, 2023 to September 23, 2023. Mr. Arvind

Choudhary, Trainer, Crush IT Techno. Mr. Arvind Choudhary explained the MERN Stack Components are: Mongo DB: Document Database, Express JS: Node Js backend web application framework, React JS: JavaScript library for UI based components and Node JS: JavaScript web server.

In the first week, Mr. Choudhary covered HTML, CSS, and JavaScript components of MERN Stack Development and at the end of week all students created a small billing application. In the second week, the trainer explained the Component creation, Data Binding (Designing UI), API integration, Validation,



Usage of JSON API and the end of the second week all students created front end with help of React JS. In the third week, he covered Nodemon package, file operations and architecture of Node Js along with Routing and middleware formation in Express JS. In the final week of the workshop, the trainer covered MongoDB installation, Node JS connectivity with MongoDB, Get and Post API integration in MongoDB and Mongoose in Node JS.

On the basis of this workshop a competition is organized for designing a website using MERN stack and two best projects were awarded. At the end of the

workshop, valedictory session was organized on September 27. 2023. Mr. Amit Joshi and Mr. Arvind Choudhary were the guests, felicitated with saplings and mementos. All the eligible students were provided with the certificates for successful accomplishment of the workshop. The certificates were given to the student who had minimum 75% attendance during the training program. The workshop was well organized by Ms. Poonam Tanwar, Ms. Ruchika Mandora, The workshop motivated students for developing websites and uncovered a new option for their career.

Self Defence Program

Self- Defence training program 'Urjita' was organized for girl students at Shri Vaishnav Khel Prashal, in collaboration with 'Punyathi Welfare Foundation', where in the team and trainers, gave 'Dand' training and 'Nondand' training to the girl students on October 9-11, 2023. Post Graduate and Under Graduate students from all the departments participated in the event. The objective of a self-defence training program was to empower the girl students with the skills, confidence, and awareness to protect themselves, make informed decisions, and enhance their personal safety in various situations, especially as the days of 'Navratri' are approaching.

Many girls go for 'dandiya' practice thus in order to keep them safe and strong in such situations it's necessary for them to know self defence. Dr. Mala Singh Thakur, Founder of 'Punyathi Welfare Foundation' Indore with the team members Ms. Chetna Malviya and Ms. Aruna Naidu, Trainers Ms. Ashvini Pal along with the team members, Ms. Vaibhavi Khudiwal and Ms. Kanisha Setpal were present for the self defence training.

At the first day of the training program the participants were divided into two groups; one group comprised of students with the 'Dand' i.e. stick and other group was without 'Dand'.

Students with 'Dand' learned the



basics, tactics and technique of gripping, front and back attack. These sticks deliver powerful strikes, increasing the chances of incapacitating an attacker. For the students without 'Dand', neck and chest punches were taught. In order to defend oneself, 'block' was also taught. Blocks provide a protective barrier. Learning these techniques empowers individuals to take action in dangerous situations along with the Training to enhance handees.

On the second & third day the revision of previous training day was done, later the importance of Vocal strength was made understood. Higher the power in voice, higher the intensity of defence will be. The students with

'Dand'; highlighted that head and leg attacks were taught, the practice was done individually as well as in pairs. The combination attacks with two upper attacks and one lower attack was also practiced, along with chest attack and blocks.

For students with no sticks, the famous self-defence technique 'Kallari Payattu' was taught; which included, two steps, known as 'Chuvadukal' in four directions, along with the voice commanding, commonly practiced as 'block, block, kick, slap, lock, chop, turn, punch', that helped students to understand the attack and defence in all the directions, which will prepare them physiologically and cognitively.
