India is a great place to produce software, yet most people are digitally literate in urban areas only. Digital literacy is nearly nonexistent in the majority of rural areas, where two thirds of the population lives. Some schools provide very limited and inadequate training tools for students from rural areas. With the aid of mobile computer lab Gyan Rath, the Institute is attempting to close the digital divide by providing the required hardware and software in rural areas and by establishing computer labs in the chosen schools that Gyan Rath already serves to ensure sustainability and continuity of computer education. It was the first computer lab established

under Gyan Rath's project.

On January 4, 2024, a certificate distribution ceremony and computer lab inauguration took place at the government school premises in Sindoda, a hamlet chosen under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. The chief guest of the event was Indore District Collector Dr. Ilyaraja T. (IAS) who formally inaugurated the event.

Following the opening, Dr. George Thomas greeted the guests and expressed gratitude for the Institute's chance to equip rural kids with the skills they need to succeed in the computer-driven culture. The noble initiative's goal was to keep up the Gyan Rath's objectives and offer computer training to students. In order to

provide rural government schools with the same opportunities as urban ones, the Institute developed a sustainable program template for computer education and digital literacy and supply the necessary resources by setting up mini computer labs and extended learning centres there.

The program's objectives were to improve the quality of teaching in rural government schools, encourage students in rural areas to pursue careers in science and technology, and develop a reusable and sustainable model to address resource and computer lab shortages in remote locations. 350 students, instructors, parents, village seniors and Sarpanch attended the program.

In addition to thanking the Institute and the Management Body for their efforts, Dr. Ilyaraja T. (IAS) gave parents and children the reassurance that the program will build the necessary competency for future success and lay the groundwork for digital literacy. Following this session, students from the school showcased a variety of cultural programs, and the event concluded with the distribution of certificates. Dr. Jagdish Sharma, Coordinator, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan & Gyan Rath, meticulously organized the event with members Dr. Poonam Nagar, Dr. Chandni Keswani, Dr. Raghav Jaiswal, Mr. Ram Bhavesh Sharan, Mr. Ravi Chouhan, Ms. Arnika Kabra & Mr. Ankur Sakalley.

Two days Workshop on Water Conservation



Two days workshop “Jal Samvad” on water conservation organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Committee in association with Vigyan Bharti and Vibha Vani on March 5-6, 2024. It was a profound exploration into the mission of “Jal Sanrakshan Jeevan Samvardhan”, bringing together a diverse audience committed to understanding and addressing the pressing concern of water conservation. The objectives of the workshop were to create awareness for water conservation by enhancing knowledge and sharing researches, to create an attitude towards water conservation, management and development so that a behavioural change can be created amongst all stakeholders; to drive people to take part in water conservation and development activities in their environs; to provide for a platform to discuss and learn water conservation, management and development techniques and also discuss the concerns for posterity; to motivate people towards sustainable use of water and other natural resources through

optimum utilization; to promote the use of water efficiently in agriculture and domestic use to enhance productivity and creating a network of field professionals and stakeholders for future activities.

The resource persons of the workshop were Shri N.P. Rajive, Vice Chairman, NIF, New Delhi, Executive Director, Vibha Vani, India, Dr. Sunil Chaturvedi, National Coordinator “Jal Samvad” Vigyan Bharti and Dr. Tripti Singh, Head, Sanstha Vranda and Tripti herbal and plantation services.

On the first day of the workshop, Dr. Rajive set the tone for the workshop and emphasized on the urgency of sustainable water practices. Dr. Chaturvedi captivated the audience with a historical journey through traditional water conservation methods. Drawing on examples such as Odhi structure in Dewas, Mokha in Baghelkhand, Shrankalabad talab in Ujjain, Kundi bandara in Burhanpur, he illustrated the richness of India’s water heritage. The session delved into the global water crisis, the water cycle, water availability on earth, and the intricate relationship between human survival and

groundwater dependency.

Technical aspects of importance of water and soil conservation structures were displayed like Contour trench, gabion, ponds, farm ponds, stop dams, well recharging, med farming, Percolation tank, Roof water harvesting are some major water conservation strategies. A thought provoking short film on water scarcity gripped the attention of audience. Dr. Sunil introduced the concept of blue, grey, and black water, providing a nounced understanding of the diverse water types and their significance and management. The point of water budgeting for basic human needs was also discussed. Dr. Tripti Singh shifted the focus to the interdependency of forest and water and underscoring the critical need for their conservation. A short film named NEER was played for showing the future needs of water that after paying a lot of money too we will not get a drop of water.

Second & final day of the workshop opened with a concise recapitulation of key insights from the first day. Grey

water management concept and technologies were thoroughly explored, with judicial use of domestic, irrigation, and industrial water. Dr. Singh steered discussion towards water safety, social audits of water sources, water quality and impact on health, various diseases, water quality test FTK kit and remedies for water related challenges.

A social movement launched for awareness of individual. The collaborative spirit of the workshop reached its pinnacle as participants collectively formulated a “Jal Samvad” action plan. Narlai village was visited by the participants where they imparted knowledge on water conservation, and demonstrate practical applications such as roof water harvesting and grey water management to the villagers. More than 70 participants were attended the workshop which included Students, faculty members from other academic institution and organisation, field professionals from NGOs, social workers and media persons. The event coordinator was Dr. Jagdish Sharma, Coordinator, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan & Community Engagement.



XI NATIONAL CASE WRITING WORKSHOP




The case method is a participatory, discussion-based way of learning where students gain skills in critical thinking, communication, and group dynamics. It is a type of problem-based learning. To encourage the use of Case method, the Case Development Cell of the Institute organized 11th National Case Writing Workshop from February 15-21, 2024 in hybrid mode. Dr. Upinder Dhar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Shri Vaishnav Vidyapeeth Vishwavidyalaya, Indore has been the resource person for the workshop. After the brief inaugural program, the pre-lunch session on the first day was based on the importance of Case study and the process of developing a Case on real life situations. The participants were divided into four groups each of comprising 4-5 participants. Each group contacted the allotted organization namely; Capitalvia, 6Degreesit, and collected the information by discussing with key persons in the organization in the second half of the day. On the second day, each group conversed with the resource person about the information collected and had the direction to draft the case. The post lunch session was focusing on drafting the case. On the third day, each group had the opportunity to read the Case in front of resource person and edit accordingly and then re-draft the Case until the final Case study outlined. On the fourth day, the speaker gave the guidelines for preparing the teaching notes which need to be included with the Case. On the fifth day, groups presented the Cases prepared by them one by one. On day sixth, facilitator explained how Case is to be taught through taking a sample case. The participants were divided into groups to discuss the case and regrouped for presentation of the given case. The workshop ended with the closing ceremony where the participants shared their feedback and appreciated the efforts of the organizers. The workshop was well organized by Dr. Dhanashree Nagar, Coordinator, Case Development Cell along with other cell members Ms. Ruchira Muchhal, Ms. Vranda Agar, Dr. Chandni Keswani, Mr. Ram Bhavesh Sharan and Ms. Jyoti Jaiswal.

The resource person was Dr. Bharat Kulkarni, Director; Stalwart Management Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd., Indore. Dr. Kulkarni explained the structure of the finance budget, its objective, revenue & expenditure analysis. It included the analysis of key trends in expenditure, various schemes being implemented, and key sectoral issues. The session highlighted the expenditure of various

ministries/departments including defence, road transport & highway, food and public distribution, rural development, agricultural, health etc. Dr. Kulkarni also emphasised that analysis of budget should be done in the light of economic indicators, economic survey, macroeconomic indicators of that economy & various assumption that had been taken in any financial budget. Total 200 students were participated in the session along with faculty members. The session inculcated the knowledge of analysis of finance budget and creates an opportunity for the students to analyze the forthcoming Interim budget, 2024. NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY



In order to commemorate the inventions of science and the discovery of the Raman Effect in India by the Indian physicist, Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman in the year 1930, the day is celebrated as National Science Day. For his great success in the field of science in India, Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman had been awarded and honoured with the Nobel Prize in the Physics. To honour this event, February 28 is observed as 'National Science Day' in India by the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) every year.

National Science Day was celebrated in the institute by Science Club. Various events including Guest Lecture, Poster Making Competition, Expert Lecture and Visit to RR CAT and UGC-DAE Consortium were organised by Department of Computer Science jointly with Science Club for the students of B.Sc programme.

Visit to the Raja Ramanna Centre for Advanced Technology (RR CAT)-A visit to RR CAT, a premier research institution specializing in nuclear science and technology was organised on February 25, 2024 for B.Sc.(CS/IT) students of the Institute. The students were privileged to tour state-of-the-art facilities, interact with researchers, and witnessed cutting-edge experiments. Different experimentalists explained the benefits and working of lasers like He-Ne laser, CO₂ Laser and demonstrated application of laser in laser cutting, laser drilling, melting surface modification using Master cam and 3D printing. The Resource Person briefed students about the use of conventional light and laser for biomedical applications such as oral cancer and cervical treatment etc. There were interesting experiment based on liquid nitrogen like demonstration on balloon blowing, cloud formation and many applications based on Charles law were also demonstrated. The experiments on Indus-I and Indus-II were also explained by the scientists and its application in energy enhancement was also explained to the students. The demonstrators answered the queries of the students very ardently. They enlightened students with the bright scope in this field. The visit offered a glimpse into the forefront of scientific research and its potential impact on society.

Expert Lecture- An expert lecture is organized in the institute on February 28, 2024 in the sequel of National Science Day celebration for Students of B.Sc. (CS and IT) II and III Year and BCA II year. Dr. Archana Lakhani, Scientist G, UGC-DAE Consortium for Scientific Research, Indore briefed the utility of science in daily life, explained the phenomena of Photoelectric Effect and illustrated how a creative thinking and observation can lead to win a scientific outlook. She expressed her views to follow dreams and never stop questioning.

Poster Making Competition - Poster is a catchy and short phrase that is used to create an appeal to your target audience and take their attention. The poster making competition was organized on February 28, 2024 for the students of Computer Science Department on the theme "National Science Day". Active and keen participation of the students was seen. Best two posters were selected based on Relevance, Creativity, Uniqueness, Originality criteria out of 80 posters. Judgment of the competition was done by Dr. Archana Lakhani, Scientist G, UGC-DAE Consortium for Scientific Research, Indore. She answered the student's queries. She also enlightened students with the bright scope in the field of Science. Mr. Harshit Ahir and Mr. Mohammed Shamim of BCA II A were the winners and Mr. Jay Jain and Adia Joshi of BCA II A were the runner-ups. Winners were felicitated by Prizes and certificates. Visit to UGC-DAE Consortium for Scientific Research- Educational Visit at UGC-DAE Consortium for Scientific Research, Indore (An Autonomous Institution of University Grants Commission, New Delhi) University Campus, was organised on February, 29 2024 for the students to know how scientists are working in the research centers and also to make students aware about latest technology used in the field of physics. First Session was addressed by Dr. A. K. Sinha, Director, about the discoveries of Dr. C.V. Raman. Students were also addressed by Dr. Vasant Sathe on the importance of Science Day and why we celebrate it. Second Session was conducted by Dr. Rajamani Raghuraman, Scientist E, who demonstrated his research projects namely; Eddy current and its applications, Crystal growth that we use in our home, Hall Effect, Superconductivity, Tesla coil etc. The entire visit was truly a learning experience. Students got to know much more interesting information related to science. It was very informative and definitely enhanced the existing knowledge of the students about the research in the field of Science.

The five-day celebration of Science Day was a resounding success, fostering a deeper appreciation for the wonders of science and technology. Through engaging activities, informative lectures, and insightful interactions, students were inspired to explore the limitless possibilities of scientific inquiry.
