Education Empowers, Ragging Devours



The Institute organized an Anti Ragging Week celebration from August 12-18, 2024 in pursuance of the circular released by the Union Grants Commission dated August 8, 2024. The event was organized and executed by Anti Ragging Committee and Literary Club. The purpose of the program was to create awareness among the students about the ill effects of ragging and to ensure that the campus remains a safe and secure place for all.

The Anti-Ragging Week included a series of engaging and informative activities that contributed to achieve the objectives. The details of the activities organized during the week were:

A session is conducted on "Evils of Ragging". The expert Dr. Rajeev Dixit conducted the session to create awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and its

legal consequences. He told that the college will take strict action against those who found ragging and / or of abetting ragging. He also told about the platform for reporting and addressing ragging complaints confidentially and promptly. Essay Writing Competition was organized on August 13, 2024. The theme of the competition was "Ragging is a Curse". The event aimed to raise awareness about the detrimental effects of ragging and to promote a campus environment free of this harmful practice. Students shared their views on the topic some of them mentioned that Ragging is a disturbing reality in the higher education system of our country. Some students expressed that ragging has claimed hundreds of innocent lives and has ruined careers of thousands of bright students, the practice is still perceived by many as

a way of 'familiarization' and an 'initiation into the world' for young college going students. Mr. Mohammad Faiz Bilal, MBA FT & Juhi Taranekar, MBA FT were the winners of the competition.

Debate Competition was organized on August 14, 2024 on the topic "Ragging is Always Harmful". The debate saw a lively exchange of ideas, with participants passionately presenting their viewpoints.
